Cinnamomum zeylanicum

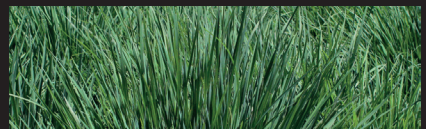

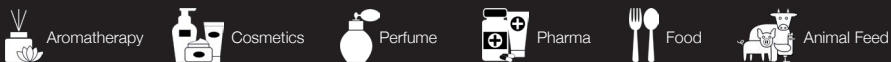
